Responding to God's whisper will give your life a sense of focus and meaning that material success or the world's applause can't begin to match. God is calling. Is your line busy?

On a recent working trip to Ghana, West Africa I had the joy of meeting this amazing lady. She is a woman of grace with a heart full of love and compassion for children...the children of Sunyani, Ghana, West Africa.

As a child Christy's life was not an easy one...as a matter of fact many of us would have a hard time imagining what it was really like for her growing up. Christy grew up in a country that is plagued by hunger, poverty and children with no homes. When she was very young Christy's father passed away making the challenges of life even greater. One of those challenges was receiving an education. Even today many villages of Africa have no schools. There is no money for paper, pencils, or books much less a teacher or a building.

Christy had such a desire within her heart to go to school. Her beloved sister worked very hard to make that a reality for Christy. As Christy attended school and the dream of an education became a reality, God put a dream within her heart for the future, a dream that all of the children in Sunyani,

Ghana and Africa would be able to receive an education. Not just an education from books, but an education that included knowledge and growth mentally, spiritually and physically, a well-rounded education for the whole being of each child.

As Christy grew up she met the man who was to become her husband, Reverend Adu-Kyeremeh. God had also placed a dream within his heart to minister to the lives of the people of Ghana, West Africa. Christy has worked diligently beside her husband as his co-laborer in the Lord for the souls of the people of Ghana. She has served and is currently serving as the President of the Women's Organization for Temple of Praise. She is the mother of four children, but has adopted many children into her home because of her great love for the children and the dream that God had placed in her heart to make a better life for the children of Ghana. After her days work is done she bakes bread, cakes and rolls to help bring income into her home. As she and Rev. Adu began their lives together, Christy shared her dream of a school for the children of Sunyani. This school was to be a school that did not just teach reading, writing and arithmetic, but a place that teaches love, and compassion and includes education for all aspects of life, emotions, the spiritual life and the physical life.

On September 28, 2004 that dream became a reality. With the overwhelming support of her husband, soul-mate and friend, Christy and Rev. Adu opened "Chris Academy" in Sunyani, Ghana, West Africa. This is a dream come true for the children of Sunyani.

The children touched my heart without a doubt as they welcomed me with pride to their school and as



they performed their program. The staff is outstanding in their dedication and love for the children and for the Director, Miss Christy. The school currently has three classrooms with 120 students and the office of the director. They are working on a second wing that will include more classrooms and a lunchroom for the children. Christy and Rev. Adu also have a dream of a third wing of three stories so that the school will include all grades.

It amazes me that the dream of a little girl became a vision and that vision has become reality, through a lot of prayer, a lot of hard work and the blessings of God. Christy Adu-Kyeremeh has touched the lives of the people of Sunyani, Ghana, West Africa not only today but for the future to come, by touching the lives of the children...the future of her country. She is very modest in receiving recognition and without hesitation gives God the glory for all that He has accomplished through her life...and I might add a life totally committed to Him. It is amazing what God can do with one life totally committed to Him.

GOD CALLING ...Continued from page 1—will know that God loves you and that He wants to give you abundant life, peace, joy, and purpose in the midst of chaos. Anything that feels like a source of life to us can become a distraction from God's call. If that thing is the source of our happiness, if we would doubt God's goodness if He asked us to let go of it, then it can close our ears to God's call. We cannot heed a new call if we are unwilling to accept the losses that come with change. We cannot heed God's call if we are in "competition with someone" or if "something is in competition" with our affection for God. Nor can we heed God's call if His voice is drowned out by the voices of people who seem more important to us than Him. When we can rest in the knowledge that God is completely good and sufficient for all our needs, then we don't need to fear whatever God will call us to do for His glory. Tune into Him with "dove's eyes". Doves have single vision; their eyes do not rotate in the sockets. They can see only one thing at a time. When we have single vision for Him, the distractions disappear, our focus is clear, and our purpose becomes visible and we serve Him with an undivided heart. Play to an Audience of One. A life lived listening to the decisive call of God is a life lived before one audience that is greater than all others—The Audience of God. Jesus Christ played to an Audience of One and so must we.
